Halal-friendly City

Home to five mosques, Hong Kong is a Muslim-friendly cosmopolitan destination that is well-suited to Muslim visitors. Catering to tourists as well as over 300,000 Muslim residents, halal-certified restaurants and food outlets are dotted around the city. Hong Kong will actively enhance tourism-support measures include providing information at the airport in Arabic and encouraging taxi fleets to provide fleet service information in Arabic; compiling a list of restaurants offering halal food; encouraging more commercial establishments to provide appropriate facilities, such as worship facilities in hotels; and stepping up staff training to strengthen their knowledge on receiving visitors from different cultural backgrounds. Muslim visitors are welcome to experience the vibrancy of Hong Kong, Asia's world city.



The Kowloon Masjid and Islamic Centre
