Internationalisation

Hong Kong's universities are highly globalised with a rich diversity of cultures At present, one in every five students of our publicly funded programmes is from outside Hong Kong.

The extent of internationalisation is even higher among faculty members. Among 6,300 academic staff, 64 per cent are from outside Hong Kong. All of them are top-notch experts, bringing in innovative ideas, cutting-edge expertise and diverse perspectives that contribute to the vibrancy and diversity of our academic community.





To attract more outstanding students along the Belt and Road to pursue their studies or career in Hong Kong, Belt and Road Scholarships have been expanded to cover all regions along the Belt and Road, as well as research postgraduate students, since the 2019/20 academic year. Starting from the 2024/25 academic year, the scholarship quota will increase by 50 per cent.
